Activities that help us maintain our mission and goals are:

The Annual Dialogue Day

The CAC annually hosts Dialogue Day, which is a forum where student leaders meet with various community leaders in hopes to build assets throughout the community. Students discuss a variety of topics, and the Coalition focuses on creating resolutions and programs to the topics that are discussed.

Mini-Dialogue Days

An extension of the annual Dialogue Day with a smaller focus at each school that pertains specifically to our youth.

Monthly Meetings

One Friday per month student representatives from our middle schools, and high schools, as well as community leaders, parents and teachers meet to discuss and plan activities and goals for the year. We meet as a whole group and then break into subcommittee work groups.

Healthy Youth/ Healthy Communities Annual Conference

The conference, an annual international gathering of youth and community leaders, focuses on the integration of the 40 assets with community partners. Each year the Coalition sends youth and adult representatives.
