RUNAWAY AND HOMELESS YOUTH

Homelessness affects people of all ages, in every community across the nation. For those individuals, each day is filled with uncertainty for food, shelter, medical care or safety.

- Between 1.6 and 2.8 million runaway and homeless youth live on the streets of America each year. (National Runaway Safeline 2013)
- Youth ages 12-17 are at higher risk of homelessness than adults.
- One out of every seven children will run away before the age of 18.
- There was a jump of more than 550% in crisis calls from homeless youth between 2000-2009 with an increase of almost 100% in 2009. (Young people up to 21, National Runaway Safeline)

Causes of Youth Homelessness:

- Running away due to physical or sexual abuse situations at home.
- Aging out of the foster care or juvenile justice system.
- Abandoned or thrown out by their family.
- Become homeless with family but are later separated by shelter, transitional living, or child welfare policies.

WHY FYI?

- FYI has nearly 40 years of experience providing shelter and counseling services to runaway and homeless youth.
- FYI is the only runaway and homeless youth service provider in Macomb County
- FYI has served over 5000 youth and their families residentially.
- 97% of youth were reported to have not runaway 90 days following the termination of services. (2012/2013)
- 96% of youth reported they felt that they gained the ability to be more responsible while at FYI. (2012/2013)

- Collaborations, partnerships and friendships throughout the community to keep youth connected and able to access resources.




