Senior Final Exams/Last Days

Senior Final Exams will take place on Wednesday, May 22nd (hours 4, 5, 6) & Thursday, May 23rd (hours 1, 2, 3). Seniors will report to school for a full day on 5/22/24 and will only attend classes for the first 3 hours of the day on 5/23/24.

Senior's Last Walk/Graduation Tickets

The Senior's Last Walk will take place on Thursday, May 23rd at 10:15am. Please access the 2024 Senior's Last Walk Map for information on where to park and to watch our Seniors walk the school grounds for the last time! All guests will stand along the front sidewalks in the front of the building to wish our Seniors farewell. Seniors should bring their graduation gown to school with them on 5/23/24. If needed, they may be hung in their locker until the walk begins. SENIORS SHOULD NOT BRING THEIR CAP/TASSEL TO SCHOOL ON THIS DAY. This event will happen rain or shine! In the event of rain, we will provide ponchos to the seniors to protect their graduation gown. When the walk is finished, Seniors can pick up their graduation tickets at the door of the Sports Lobby (located along the bus loop). NOTE: Tickets are issued to Seniors ONLY – signature is required. If your Senior is unable to pick-up their tickets on the day of the walk, they can pick them up in the office after 5/23 with Mrs. Kopczyk anytime from 7:30am-1:30pm.

Senior Fines/Diploma Holds

As we approach the last couple month left of high school for your Senior, we strongly suggest that your student begins to take care of turning in any items that may cause a hold to be put on their diploma. Fines that are not paid prior to graduation will result in a diploma hold for your Senior. Fines can be for, but not limited to: school textbooks, chromebooks, athletic equipment, Band/Choir/Art equipment, unpaid parking permit, etc. All Seniors must meet their community service & curriculum requirements in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. A diploma & graduation ticket hold will be issued for those Seniors not meeting these requirements. Official notices of diploma holds will be distributed soon to Seniors.
