All hours are due by the end of the student's senior year or will be subject to a diploma hold.

Prom Outside Guest Forms are available in the Main Office. Forms are due no later than Friday, May 3rd 3:00pm and must be approved by an LCHS Administrator before tickets can be purchased for the guest. Please encourage your Senior to read the entire form so they understand the rules & requirements. Forms missing information or that are delivered to LCHS incorrectly will not be accepted.

Senior Prom Tickets

Prom Ticket sales continue & will be sold on the following dates: 5/6, 5/8, 5/9 & 5/10. Tickets will be sold after school ONLY in the Cafeteria (students will line up in the Commons at the Cafeteria door) for \$50.00 each. Cash & check (made payable to: LCHS) will be accepted. Senior dues must be paid before a ticket can be purchased. Reminder: A guest form, approved by an LCHS Administrator, MUST be on file before a ticket can be purchased for a guest.

Graduation Cap Decorating

Seniors that plan on decorating their graduation cap should refer to the <u>Graduation Cap Decorating Rules/Guidelines</u> form for decorating. Students not complying to the guidelines will not be permitted to walk the stage at graduation. L'Anse Creuse High School does not have extra graduation caps, so please make sure the rules outlined are followed.

Senior Fines/Diploma Holds

As we approach the last weeks left of high school for your Senior, we strongly suggest that your student begins to take care of turning in any items that may cause a hold to be put on their diploma. Fines that are not paid prior to graduation will result in a diploma hold for your Senior. Fines can be for, but

not limited to: school textbooks, chromebooks, athletic equipment, Band/Choir/Art equipment, unpaid parking permit, etc. All Seniors must meet their community service & curriculum requirements in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. A diploma & graduation ticket hold will be issued for those Seniors not meeting these requirements. Official notices of diploma holds will be distributed soon to Seniors.
