

## Students Not Feeling Well/Attendance

If your student is ill, please do not send them to school. We kindly ask for them to remain home until they are 24-hours symptom free. Please contact the LCHS Attendance Office to report your child's absence at (586) 783-6400. If your student tests positive for Covid-19, access the <a href="Covid-19 Reporting">Covid-19 Reporting</a>
Form. Once you have submitted the information for your student, a notification will be sent to Pam Brooks, LCPS CDC Rep and to LCHS. Parents do not need to call to report that your student has tested positive for Covid-19. NOTE: all attendance will be marked accordingly within 24 business hours of when we are notified of the student's absence from class. We appreciate your cooperation and patience.

#### **Parking Permits**

If your student drives a vehicle to school, a 23-24 Parking Permit is required. Parking Permits are \$30.00 & are processed electronically only. Payment and all of the required information must be submitted before a parking permit will be issued. Students that drive to school without purchasing a parking permit for the current year are subject to diploma hold their senior year.

- Login to SchoolPay to pay for your parking permit
- Access the <u>23-24 Parking Permit Form</u>, completing the required areas and submitting pictures of the student's valid driver's license and the vehicle registration of each vehicle that needs to be permitted.
- The parking permit will be distributed to your student during school when all of the required information has been received.
- NOTE: Parking Permits are only valid for the school year printed on the permit and expire at the end of the school day on the last day of that school year.

## Staff Parking Lot

As a reminder, the back parking lot (along the baseball & football fields) is reserved for **STAFF ONLY Monday-Friday 5:30am-3:00pm**. Parent/Students are prohibited from using this parking lot during these days/times. Violators are subject to ticketing.

## Student Drop-Off/Pick-Up Procedure

Please review the procedures for <u>Drop-Off</u> & <u>Pick-Up</u> for before and after school. NOTE: Vehicles that wait/park on Reimold in line to get into the drop-off/pick-up lane are subject to ticketing. Other options for drop-off/pick-up are the designated areas in the front parking lot that are highlighted in the drop-off/pick-up procedures. Drop-Off & Pick-Up is strictly prohibited in the Staff Parking Lot. We appreciate your cooperation.

## Visitors To The Building

All visitors to LCHS **MUST** enter the building through the front doors into the Commons at all times. During school hours, visitors must present a valid driver's license or state id to enter the building beyond the Commons. Visitors will be issued a visitor's pass and must turn it back into the receptionist before exiting the building. We appreciate your cooperation.

## SchoolPay

LCPS has transitioned from PaySchools to SchoolPay for parents/guardians to purchase school related items for their student. SchoolPay can be accessed through your parent portal account. NOTE: SchoolPay can only be accessed when logging on to your parent portal through a desktop computer or a browser. ## Away Game Admission Policies

- Payment protocols vary by school. Please make sure you check the away school's website for information on how to obtain entry at their facility. Some schools require entry purchase online BEFORE the event.
- Students are REQUIRED to have their actual ID when attending an away game. Most schools WILL NOT accept a photo copy of an ID, picture of an ID, a coach or LCHS staff member vouching for the student

or bringing up their profile in PowerSchool. Students that do not have an actual ID will not be permitted entry into the game. This is per the away school's policy.

## Community Service Hours Required Per Class

Class of 2024 graduation requirement is 30 hours\*

- 100 Hours must be turned in by MARCH 1, 2024 to receive the Presidential Award
- 80 Hours must be turned in by APRIL 12, 2024 to receive Honor Cord
- 30 Hours must be turned in by APRIL 26, 2024 to receive Diploma

Class of 2025 graduation requirement is 40 hours Class of 2026 graduation requirement is 40 hours Class of 2027 graduation requirement is 40 hours

All hours are due by the end of the student's senior year or will be subject to a diploma hold.
