The May 7, 2024 Election is fast approaching, and as you know L'Anse Creuse Public Schools has a bond proposal on the ballot. The bond proposal will fund over 750 projects throughout the district, and **it is** 

projected that the bond will not increase the current tax rate! With a 0-mill net increase over the prior year's levy, if voters vote "YES," the millage rate for LCPS will remain at the current level. If voters vote "NO," the millage rate will remain at the current level and not begin to change until 2029.

The bond proposal is designed to update and replace aging infrastructure and improve safety and security at all facilities. Here at MSC a successful election will result in the enhancement of the educational programs and services that we provide, including:

- 1. Replace instructional technology and student devices
- 2. Install emergency alert system and enhance security cameras
- 3. Replace parking lot, driveways, and sidewalks
- 4. Upgrade building flooring and furniture
