NOTICE TO PARENTS

MICHIGAN WEEK: May 16-22 is Michigan Week in all the schools of the state. You are cordially invited to visit your school during this period. We will have a music program on Friday, May 21 at 1.30 p.m. by grades 1-5 which you are especially invited to attend.

KINDERGARTEN ROUND-UP: The kindergarten round-up, a registration and orientation program for parents of children entering the Atwood School in the fall, will be held on Wednesday, May 26 at 1.30 p.m. in the multi-purpose room. This program is for parents only; arrangements may be made for children to visit the school after the round-up with the kindergarten teachers. Please bring your child's birth certificate. Children must be at least 5 years old on December 1, 1965. AFTERNOON KINDERGARTEN CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD ON ROUND-UP DAY.

★ BOARD OF EDUCATION REPORT: Mr. Donald Yacks, President of the L'Anse Creuse Board of Education, reported to the Atwood P.T.A. on May 12 that the Board had decided on the issues to be voted on June 14.

- 1. An increase of four mills for increased operating costs: new teaching personnel, increased transportation, increased custodial service and salary increases, which will total \$234,000 for 1965-66.

This additional millage will cost approximately \$25 for a Macomb County home evaluated for tax purposes at \$2,000.

- 2. An increase of .4 mills for increased construction costs. This will enable the Board to borrow \$400,00 to complete the construction program. (Fire marshal requirements, for example, will cost a minimum of \$82,000.)

As there will be a reduction of .4 mills for debt service in 1965-66, the adoption of this proposal would, in effect, be a continuation of the present debt tax rate rather than an increase.

Please note that this information was given orally. An official written statement will be issued in the near future.
