We are pleased to announce graduation for the Class of 2024 will be held on **Wednesday**, **June 5th at 7:00pm**. Seniors will receive **8** tickets for graduation. The graduate does not need a ticket for graduation. If you are need of additional tickets, please check with other Class of 2024 families who may not be utilizing all of their graduation tickets. ## Senior Fines/Diploma Holds

As we approach the last month left of high school for your Senior, we strongly suggest that your student begins to take care of turning in any items that may cause a hold to be put on their diploma. Fines that are not paid prior to graduation will result in a diploma hold for your Senior.
