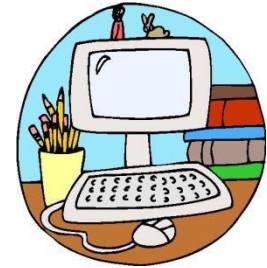
ATTENDANCE POLICY

ATTENDANCE IS CRUCIAL TO A SUCCESSFUL OUTCOME.

Classes meet from 8:00–11:00 am, 12-3 pm, and 4-7 pm Monday through Thursday. Class is structured in a learning lab setting where students can work on individual curriculum at their own pace. A variety of learning methods are utilized, including books and computer programs that can be used in class and are available 24/7 from home.



PROXY HOURS



- IN ADDITION TO SEAT TIME, YOU ARE ABLE TO ACCRUE ATTENDANCE HOURS BY WORKING ON APPROVED COURSEWORK (PLATO) FROM HOME.
- PLATO IS AN INTERNET BASED CURRICULUM THAT ALLOWS YOU TO WORK OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM 24/7.
- THIS METHOD OF STUDY MUST BE COORDINATED WITH THE STAFF IN ORDER FOR YOUR HOURS TO BE COUNTED.

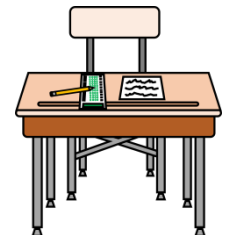
GED PREPARATION & TESTING

WE OFFER A COMPREHENSIVE GED PREPARATION AND TESTING OPPORTUNITY FOR ELIGIBLE STUDENTS.

COST FOR GED TEST: \$37.50 PER SECTION (TOTAL COST \$150.00)

TO RECEIVE AN INSTRUCTOR APPROVED VOUCHER, WHICH WAIVES THE COST OF THE GED TEST, STUDENTS MUST:

- ✓ COMPLETE AT LEAST 40 HOURS OF INSTRUCTION, SCORE APPROPRIATE LEVELS ON PROGRAM ASSESSMENT (PRE AND POST ASSESSMENT) AND MEET ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS.
- ✓ A “LIKELY TO PASS” SCORE IS REQUIRED ON THE OFFICIAL GED PRACTICE TEST.

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

- ENTRY INTO HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA CLASSES IS DETERMINED AFTER EVALUATION OF YOUR TRANSCRIPT.
- IF YOU ARE AN ADULT STUDENT (22 OR OVER) YOU MUST SCORE A MINIMUM OF 239 ON A PRE-TEST TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION.



POST TESTING

- THE STATE OF MICHIGAN REQUIRES ALL PARTICIPANTS (AGE 22 AND OLDER) TO PRE-TEST AND POST-TEST.
- NO CREDIT/VOUCHER WILL BE ISSUED TO A STUDENT WHO DOES NOT POST TEST AND SHOW GAIN (1 EFL MINIMUM)



PARTICIPANT FOLLOW-UP



- ❖ THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND ECONOMIC GROWTH FUNDS OUR PROGRAM.
- ❖ THEY REQUIRE US TO DO FOLLOW-UP PHONE SURVEYS FOR STUDENTS OVER 22 YEARS OF AGE ONCE THEY LEAVE THE PROGRAM.
- ❖ IF YOU ARE CALLED BY OUR STAFF FOR FOLLOW-UP, YOUR COOPERATION WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED. THE SURVEY WILL ONLY TAKE A FEW MINUTES.

*Proof of residency (see residency guidelines)



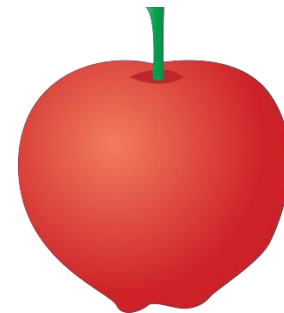
***RESIDENCY GUIDELINES**

Any one item listed **(MUST be original documents, current and dated within 30 days of registration)**: Utility bill, cell phone bill, current automobile loan or lease, insurance statement or bank statement. The above list is examples; other proofs may be deemed acceptable.

If you are 22 years of age or older on or before
September 1 of the current school year:

Required items for registration:

- Birth Certificate
- Valid Picture identification
- Transcript
- Piece of mail showing your name and current address
