### ***Students Not Feeling Well/Attendance***

If your student is ill, please do not send them to school. We kindly ask for students to remain home until they are 24-hours free of fever or vomiting and their symptoms are improving. Please contact the LCHS Attendance Office to report your child's absence at (586) 783-6400. **NOTE: all attendance will be marked accordingly within 24 business hours of when we are notified of the student's absence from class.** We appreciate your cooperation and patience.

### ***Student ID's Required***

Student ID's are required for all students while in the building for any reason. This means students have to wear their ID during the school day & for an after-school activity such as, but not limited to, athletic practices, club meetings, band practice, etc. ID's must be visible on the lanyard they were provided by the school. Students that do not have a school assigned lanyard can see Mrs. DuChene in the Counseling Office. In addition, Student ID's are required for entry into any games, dances or other building events.

- Payment protocols vary by school. Please make sure you check the away school's website for information on how to obtain entry at their facility. Some schools require entry purchase online **BEFORE** the event.
- Students are **REQUIRED** to have their actual ID when attending an away game. Most schools **WILL NOT** accept a photo copy of an ID, picture of an ID, a coach or LCHS staff member vouching for the student or bringing up their profile in PowerSchool. Students that do not have an actual ID will not be permitted entry into the game. This is per the away school's policy.

### ***Community Service Hours Required***

All students are required to complete a minimum of 40 hours of Community Service before graduation. These hours are a graduation requirement. We highly recommend students complete their 40 hours **BEFORE their Senior year**. Students that do not submit their served hours before the end of their senior year are subject to a diploma hold and will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.

### ***Class of 2025 Community Service Deadlines:***

- **100 Hours must be turned in by FEBRUARY 28, 2025** to receive the Presidential Award
- **80 Hours must be turned in by MARCH 20, 2025** to receive Honor Cord
- **40 Hours must be turned in by APRIL 25, 2025** to receive Diploma
