# **Grades and Citizenship**

Football athletes must not be on the citizenship list (behavior based). Also, all athletes must meet MSS Athletic eligibility. All athletes' grades and citizenship will be monitored weekly. If an athlete is deemed ineligible (2 or more F's), they will sit out the next game, as well as have to attend mandatory study hours during practice time one day per week until those grades are improved. Failure to attend study hours or improve the poor grades could result in removal from the team.

### **Attendance**

A calendar listing the practices and games for the season is attached. Practices are scheduled from 3:00-5:00 after school each day. Please have a ride ready to pick your student/athlete at the appropriate times. We understand that sometimes doctor or dentist appointments come up, if for some reason you are not able to schedule those around our practices, please email a coach if your athlete will be absent from practice. Due to restructured Wednesdays, there will be no practices on those days.

### **Behavior**

Football athletes must adhere to all school rules and policies at all times during the season. This means that you treat coaches and fellow players in a respectful manner by listening and following directions the first time they are given. Since you are representing our school, athletes are required to uphold a high level of behavior and conduct. Suspension or removal from the team may result if school rules are broken.

## <u>Uniforms</u>

Each football athlete will be given a compete set of equipment at the start of the season. The entire uniform will be collected immediately following the final game of the season. If a uniform is not returned, the athlete will be prohibited from participating in their grade's end of the year activity. In addition, if any portion of the equipment is missing or damaged, it is the athlete's responsibility to pay for it.

Replacement cost for the jerseys alone is \$\frac{\$100}{}\$, so please take care of ALL of your equipment!

\*Athletes are responsible for purchasing their own <u>mouth guards</u>. They can be purchased from us for \$2.00 each or you may purchase one at any local sporting goods store. The mouth guard MUST be able to attach to their helmet and be a solid color so the referee can see it (not clear colored).
