Each year a John Wayne Sellers Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to one graduating senior of L'Anse Creuse Public Schools in the amount of \$1,250.

Selection Criteria/Requirements:

- Students should fill out their academic scholarship application at their home school.
- Applicant must be a L'Anse Creuse High School or L'Anse Creuse High School North Student.
- Applicant attended the Pankow Center, CTE/MST program and has earned at least two (2) credits by graduation.
- Applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average.
- The financial need of the student will be considered.
- Character, citizenship, leadership and participation in school activities will be considered.
- Applicant must attend a career and technical program through a trade school, college or university as a full-term student or have a full-time job offer.
- Applicant should provide two recommendations; one from a L'Anse Creuse staff member and one from a non-relative adult.
- Applicant should submit a 250-word essay stating why they should be awarded the scholarship.
- A copy of their transcript should accompany their completed application.

Selection and Presentation of Scholarship

The scholarship will be selected by family and friends of John Sellers, including Board Member Shane Sellers or their designee. The scholarship will be announced and presented to the student during the Pankow Center honors convocation ceremony.
