Deadline – February 28, 2025 - Late or Incomplete application WILL NOT be considered

*The following scholarships are designed to assist Pankow Center students with post-secondary education expenses.
Award is based on evidence of a career goal and post-secondary planning stated in the essay, and through teacher recommendations.
Character, citizenship, leadership, community service, participation in extra-curricular activities, and financial need may be considered.*

***FOR HORTICULTURE SCIENCE STUDENTS ONLY**

Criteria for selection & eligibility for ALL FVP Scholarships:

- Must be a senior student enrolled at The Pankow Center and have earned at least one credit by graduation (see additional requirements for specific scholarships if applicable).
- Applicants must have at least a 2.5 grade point average for all CTE scholarships
****FVP Outstanding Senior Scholarship must have a minimum 3.0 GPA****
- Financial need will be considered.
- Character, citizenship, leadership, community service and participation in extra- curricular activities will be considered.
- Applicants must attend a career and technical program through a college or technical training school, or a program to earn a minimum of an Associate's Degree or program certification.
- Two recommendations are required;
 - One from a Pankow Center Teacher
 - One from another non-relative adult, L'Anse Creuse staff or other
- Applicants must complete the online application:
- Applicants must submit a 100-150 word essay stating their career goals and why they should be awarded the scholarship.

FVP Scholarships Continued.....

- Applicants must submit a copy of their transcript.
- Applicants must submit evidence of community service hours performed.
- OPTIONAL: Additional documents may be uploaded and considered: additional recommendations, awards, portfolio, and resume or acceptance letters.

Timeline and Review Process:

February 28, 2025 –Applications due. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applications will be reviewed and selected by the Pankow Scholarship Staff Committee. All decisions are final.

Scholarship recipients will be invited in April to attend and accept the award at the Pankow Center Honor's Convocation Event in May. See *Pankow Important Dates Calendar* on our webpage for date and time.

BEFORE YOU START: Tips on filling out online scholarship forms in Google Forms

1. Ask two people to be a reference. Ask their permission and give ample time before the due date for a reference person to write and send you an electronic letter. Teachers may submit a *Teacher Recommendation form* instead of a letter if they prefer.
 - one from a L'Anse Creuse Pankow Center Teacher
 - one from another non-relative adult

**The names you submit in the google application form must match the names on the letters you receive.*
2. Request an electronic copy of your transcript through Parchment. Allow ample time to obtain and receive this.
3. Prepare and type a thoughtful 100-150 word essay clearly describing your career plans/goals and state why you should be rewarded the scholarship. You may want to cut and paste from a Word document. Be sure your essay is free of typos and grammatical errors.
